#### Environment

At Tulmar, we are acutely aware of the obligations we have to our community and our environment. We have implemented a variety of recycling and air quality programs to reduce our impact on the environment, knowing that we must take a lead in protecting this legacy for future generations. Through Lean Manufacturing initiatives we reduce scrap and waste in our manufacturing processes.
